SHAPE AND GROWTH	Globular and compact with a mounding growth habit
PLANTTYPE	Broadleaf evergreen
FLOWER	White double flowers with sweet fragrance
BLOOM TIME	Spring to dormancy
FRUIT	N/A
FOLIAGE	Dark green
ZONE	7
LIGHT	Full sun to part shade
SOIL	Prefers acidic, moist, well-drained soil, pH 5.0-6.0
PRUNING OR SHEARING	Requires little to no pruning
LANDSCAPE USES	Border hedge, specimen, container, cutting garden
ORIGIN/PARENTAGE	Bred by Phil Dark, Oakmont Nursery, Siler City, NC, seedling selection from open pollination of 'Chuck Hayes'
PROPAGATION	Softwood stem cuttings
DISEASE RESISTANCE	Moderate resistance to whitefly, neither susceptibility nor resistance to normal gardenia diseases and pests
PLANT NOTES	Does not abort flower buds to heat stress Recurrent flowering from spring until dormancy Drought resistant
